If You Are A Seller



Wipe down all surfaces after showings.



If a family member is not feeling well, do not have showings.



Leave cabinet doors, closet doors and any other spaces a buyer may want to see open.



Provide hand disinfectant upon entry to your home for visitors to use.

If You Are A Buyer



Drive your own vehicle to showings.



Wash or disinfect your hands after each showing.



Wear booties or shoe covers during showings.



Do not touch surfaces while touring properties.



If you are not feeling well, do not attend showings or open houses.
